Please keep items clean and reusable. No furniture at this time.

How it works

1. Fill a bag — Gather what your family no longer wears or uses.
2. Drop it off / leave it out — Bring it to the collection point or leave it at your door.
3. We do the rest — We pick it up — it becomes inventory for a small business.

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Host Guide & Checklist

Everything you need to run a successful Clothes for Cause clothing drive, from the first announcement to pickup day.

3-4 WEEKS OUT

- Call or text us at 281-932-9578 to lock in your drive dates.
- Pick a visible collection spot (front office, lobby, fellowship hall).
- Name one point of contact for our team.

2 WEEKS OUT

- Print and post this flyer where people gather.
- Send the first announcement — email, newsletter, group chat.
- Tell people what qualifies: clean, reusable, no furniture.

1 WEEK OUT

- Send a reminder with the exact dates and drop-off spot.
- Have bags or bins ready and labeled.
- Schools: announce the class-vs-class competition and the prize.

DRIVE WEEK

- Post a daily nudge — momentum builds in the last 48 hours.
- Keep the collection area tidy so it stays inviting.
- Snap a few photos to share with your community.

PICKUP DAY

- Have bags gathered near a loading area or at each doorstep.
- Our team loads everything — no lifting required from you.
- Send a thank-you note with the results. People love the follow-up.

"The bag in your closet isn't trash — it's someone's starting inventory. An entrepreneur in Haiti, Kenya or Guatemala buys it for pennies, sells it in her market stall, and feeds her family that week."
